What to Bring

Everyone attending camp will need a lunch, small water bottle, swimsuit, and towel daily. Tennis shoes are also a good idea instead of sandals or flip flops. Due to the energy expended at camp, please provide enough food for lunch and possibly a light snack during the day. It is helpful to bring your personal items (all clearly marked) in a small day pack. All lost and found items will be kept for 30 days and then given to a local charity organization. Please try to keep the child's pack light as they carry it with them throughout the day.

5. Finish completing the form and paying online.

- Thursday night from 6:30pm to 8:30pm.
- Families of current day campers are invited to spend an evening at Tilikum.
- Opportunity for families to see the program up close, participate in some of the activities with their children, and enjoy a short program of singing, sharing and day camp fun.
- Campers will return to the church by bus at approximately 5:00pm as usual and then families are encouraged to attend Family Night at 6:30pm.
