-For security purposes, BLBC has a closed campus policy. As a general rule, we do not allow visitors during the Weekend.

#### **What to Bring:**

- **Clothes:** Warm, active, rain coat, work clothes & shoes, etc.)
- **Bedding:** Bed sheets, sleeping bag, pillow)
- **Personal items:** Toiletries, towel, laundry bag, etc.)
- **Don't Forget:** Bible, notebook, and pen
- **Optional items:** Camera, flashlight, umbrella, water bottle, snacks
- **Medications:** All medications brought to camp must be in its original container and in a Ziploc bag labeled as follows: *Church name and camper name and date of birth.* ex. (VBC – Joe Camper 1/1/1998)
- **Spending Money:** Recommended amount \$20-\$30 for The Weekend. The Camp Store will be open Saturday & Sunday to purchase snacks, beverages, apparel and souvenirs. Theophilus merchandise & Westward Music will also be available throughout The Weekend.

**Due to limited space, students will be limited to ONE suitcase. Individuals with more than one suitcase will not be allowed to ride the bus. Note: Sleeping bag & pillow can be in a separate small bag**

**Do NOT Bring:** Drugs, Tobacco, or Alcohol of any kind, Pornography, Weapons, Fireworks, Knives, etc.

#### **Paintball:**

The paintball waiver is enclosed in this letter. If you plan to play, bring this signed waiver and enough money to play. (cost is \$20 for 2 hours) Also, bring appropriate clothes to wear while playing (i.e. no shorts or short sleeves, jacket, gloves, active shoes, etc.)
