Ministry & Job Specific Qualifications

- 1. Must demonstrate biblical and theological competency especially, in the area of Kingdom of God theology
- 2. Must have knowledge and experience in small group ministry
- 3. Must be diligent, be a self-motivator, and be highly relational with interpersonal skills and compassion
- 4. Must have proven preaching and teaching ability
- 5. Must have a good understanding in, be an advocate for multicultural church and ministry
- 6. Must have experience in intercultural ministry
- 7. Must be gifted in leadership, having at least five full-time years of experience in church context
- 8. Must have good communication skills in both Korean and English, with heart language in Korean and relative fluency in English at all three levels: personal, public and written.
