

Ministry Support Job Description

Assistant Nursery Supervisor

General Personal & Spiritual Qualifications

- 1. Profess personal faith in Jesus Christ as evidenced by spiritual growth and passion for God.
- 2. Model biblical integrity in the role and duties of the job. (Titus 2:7-8)
- 3. Model biblical community in relationships as described in the "one another" commands in Scripture.
- 4. Embrace Village's Mission, Vision, and Values modeling a commitment to helping the church realize these goals.
- 5. Support a multi-staff and multi-cultural team ministry.
- 6. Be willing to honor and respect Village's doctrinal statement, covenant, position statements, and policies.

Job Specific Qualifications

- 1. Must love children and have prior experience working with children.
- 2. Must be physically able to lift and care for children.
- 3. Must be coachable and able to take direction from the nursery supervisor.
- Must be current in CPR/First Aid Certification.
- 5. Must conduct himself or herself in accordance with the character of Christ when serving children and parents.
- 6. Must be at least 21 years of age.
- 7. Must be a Community or Covenantal Member of Village Church.

Primary Job Responsibilities

- 1. Assist Nursery Supervisor in the operations and activities in all 3 rooms, as assigned and/or directed by Nursery Supervisor.
- 2. Provide an environment where Christian principles are modeled and taught.
- 3. Supervise volunteer nursery staff.
- 4. Oversee all areas of operation in the nursery in accordance with nursery procedures and handbooks.
- 5. Maintain a neat, sanitary, caring, courteous, and safe nursery environment.
- 6. In the absence of the supervisor, assess the adult/child ratio, and either obtain additional help or release help.
- 7. In the absence of the supervisor, receive children, and contact parents if a problem arises, then return child(ren).
- 8. Be actively familiar with the needs and sensitivities of children and parents.
- 9. Encourage and model interactivity with the children.

- 10. In the absence of the supervisor, see that volunteers are welcomed in the nursery, understand their responsibilities, and are placed in appropriate locations.
- 11. In the absence of the supervisor be able to carry out all emergency procedures such as evacuations, lock-downs and lock-outs.
- 12. Be available to assume any role assignment directed by supervisor as need arises.

Relationships

- 1. Reports to Nursery Supervisor.
- 2. Receives an annual review from Nursery Supervisor according to the review policy established by the Personnel Commission.
- 3. Be ultimately responsible to the Director of Kids' Ministry.
