- 5. Be in full agreement with Village's Doctrinal Statement, Church Covenant, and Mission Statement.
- 6. Understand and be willing to submit to Village's Strategic Plan, Position Statements, and Policies.

Job Specific Qualifications

- 1. Must have a minimum of 5 years of experience in their craft.
- 2. Displays cooperative and helpful attitude in communications and projects with ministry team.
- 3. Be able to produce within deadlines stipulated for art showcases
- 4. Role of Artist in Residency ends after December 2025.

Primary Job Responsibilities

- 1. Create original art complementing the ministry theme and vision of "Prophetic Imagination"
- 2. Showcase original artwork for three art showcases scheduled in April, September, and December. Showcases may include other local artists.
- 3. Lead workshops or seminars for Village Church focused on Art + Theology to facilitate congregational formation.
- 4. Engage with both the church congregation and the broader community, using art as a tool to inspire, reflect, and promote unity.
- 5. Collaborate with the Worship and Arts ministry team to align the artwork with the church's values, theology, and preaching series.
- 6. Donate some art pieces created during the residency to Village Church.
